## **Approaching Deadlines For Juniors:**

- Goldwater Scholarship: STEM scholarship for students planning to pursue a research based doctoral, medical or veterinary medicine, or medical/veterinary + doctoral degree graduate program. You must follow our campus application instructions. Campus Application Deadline: 12 December
- <u>Truman Scholarship</u>: For change agents. Provides funding for graduate study anywhere worldwide and in any discipline. You must follow our campus application instructions. Campus Application Deadline: 22 December
- <u>Boren Scholarship</u>: (for summer STEM study abroad): For STEM majors to study abroad
  in a non-western country, must include language study. See <u>official website</u> for details.
  You must follow our campus application instructions. Campus Application Deadline: 30
  December
- <u>Elie Wiesel Prize in Ethics</u>: Although the Foundation offers suggest topics, applicants are encouraged to choose any subject they feel strongly about, provided it is related to the domain of ethics. Examples of winning essays can be found on their website. Prizes range from \$10K to \$1K. Essay length: 3,000 to 4,000 words. Official Deadline: 30 December
- Humanity in Action Fellowship Explore issues of social justice, human rights, politics of memory and remembrance culture, and civic engagement. Examine ways in which communities co-exist to create a pluralistic society, and the structural challenges arising from asymmetrical power dynamics. This 12 month fellowship includes a summer experience in a host country plus your own action program. Program locations: US, Berlin, Copenhagen, Warsaw, Amsterdam and Sarajevo. Applicants select program of their choice. Applications open 5 December/Official Deadline early January (date TBD)
- Zero Hunger Internship A 10 week paid summer internship working with anti-hunger organizations, includes seminars, leadership development, experience working with nonprofit operations, policy analysis, program implementation, fundraising practices, and a group research project as well as other perks. Official Deadline: 13 January
- <u>Beinecke</u> Provides 2 years of funding for research based postgraduate study in the arts, humanities or social sciences anywhere world-wide. Open to US citizens or US nationals.
   <u>Campus Application Deadline:</u> 18 January
- <u>Udall</u> For sophomores/juniors with a commitment to issues related to the environment or Native American nations. Students must be US citizens, US nationals or Permanent Residents <u>and/or</u> Native Americans, Alaskan Natives or members of First Nations of Canada. Campus Application Deadline: 30 January
- Amgen Scholars Program (US) STEM students interested in biotechnology or biomedical sciences, engage in summer full-time independent research projects under the guidance of a research scientist. Visit each Amgen host institution for project/discipline foci. Includes seminars, research symposium, and networking events. Open to US citizens, permanent residents, or DACA. Official Deadline: 1 February
- <u>Amgen Scholars Program (Asia)</u> STEM students interested in biotechnology or biomedical sciences, engage in summer full-time independent research projects under
